### Ambassadors

Each year the FTCC student Ambassador program provides eight outstanding students the opportunity to represent Fayetteville Technical Community College. The Ambassador organization is an honorary service group whose members serve as public relations support and assist with College events and functions.

In order to be selected, each prospective Ambassador must have completed at least 12 credit hours at FTCC, have at least a 2.5 GPA, and be recommended by three members of the College community. Applicants must also undergo an interview, selection, and orientation process.

Each Ambassador receives a \$700 FTCC Foundation, Inc. scholarship, official attire, and the recognition and prestige associated with the title. The Ambassadors:

- provide campus tours for small groups
- assist with registration
- attend special events to represent the student body
- assist with official campus visits by VIPs
- attend community events to represent the College
