

The Blackboard® Learning System is a course management system used by the college to support on-line, hybrid and traditional classes. This technology based platform allows students to complete their work from remote locations and ensures students in outlying areas have immediate access for continuing their educational studies. Instructors in traditional (face-to-face) classrooms are also using blackboard as a supplement to their lectures and in-class exercises to enhance student learning. This technology allows instructors to communicate quickly with all students in a class, to distribute information instantly and to encourage interaction between students on line. Additionally, Blackboard assists the faculty and staff with various standing and adhoc committee work, by allowing committees to create blackboard sites that include discussion boards, resource pages and other useful document repositories. Blackboard is used by Counseling Services for presentations and workshops. The Student Government Association uses Blackboard to announce club activities and notify students of school events.
