SUPPORT OF JOHN L. THROCKMORTON LIBRARY

FTCC will make available from its campus in Fayetteville, North Carolina, additional library support to ensure that requisite standards necessary to maintain accreditation are met or exceeded.

FTCC will provide or arrange for adequate library references, research materials, supplementary materials, texts and micro-form as needed to support each discipline at the FTCC library. Library resources from the Main Campus are available for use by FTCC students and include 62,936 volumes, 3,094 microforms, 365 periodicals and 7,738 audiovisual materials. Library materials can also be obtained by the FTCC Librarian through microfiche.

FTCC will provide books and volumes to be held in a reserve section for use by its students. The FTCC Library will make current NCLive passwords and passwords of other databases available to its students. The Librarian at FTCC may request inter-library loans from the Fort Bragg Post Library. Reciprocal loans will be available.

FTCC will coordinate the use of the John L. Throckmorton Library with the Post Librarian. Further, FTCC agrees to assist the United States Army and the US Government in preventing the loss of borrowed or inter-library loans from the Library.

In addition to FTCC's support of the Library, FTCC will provide 40 new computers and maintain seven computer labs for FTCC students enrolled in courses at the Soldier Development Center on Fort Bragg, building 2-1728. All FTCC software used at Fort Bragg will be coordinated with the Installation Director of Information Management to insure that FTCC is teaching the software systems that the Army uses/requires. All software on these machines will be provided by FTCC.
