Admissions - adheres to an "Open Door" admissions policy. High school graduates, persons achieving a North Carolina equivalency certificate (GED), and adults who show potential for post high school education may be admitted to courses which are appropriate to their educational potential

<u>Credit For Prior Learning</u> - is non-college or experience-based learning that has been attained outside the sponsorship of accredited postsecondary education institutions.

<u>Career Center</u> - provides assistance and information about choosing a major, exploring job interests, learning about job requirements and salaries, and selecting a career

Counseling Services - composed of professional educators with extensive training in counseling and guidance, who assist students in developing skills and attitudes needed to deal effectively with their surroundings

Financial Aid - provides students with financial aid assistance through loan programs, scholarships, and federal grants

Registrar-- conducts registration for classes, maintain all academic records including transcripts for current and former students


