

The Media Service Department assists faculty and staff with the identification, acquisition and use of audio-visual equipment to enhance instructional delivery. State of the art audio-visual equipment and technical support ensures that instructors have necessary instructional tools in their classrooms to show videos, pictures, web pages and documents, and to show Power Point presentations. Televisions and DVD players are installed in classrooms, along with computers, internet access, and video projectors. In the rare occasions that the technology is not immediately available in the classroom, instructors can request multi-media carts with computers and televisions that are delivered to the classroom by the Media staff. Additionally, the Media Services Department assists faculty and staff with multi-media development and presentation by providing laptop computers, video cameras, streaming and podcasting. They help to develop videos, photography for developing web pages, web design and web support that assist faculty and staff across the campus.
