FTCC WIRELESS NETWORK INFORMATION

FTCC WIRELESS IS HERE

Phase I - Effective 3/2/09

Wireless is available in most buildings on the FTCC main campus, however, complete indoor coverage is not guaranteed at this time. Indoor coverage may vary based on the construction of the building you are in and users may experience some "bleed-through" coverage near windows, doors, and main lobbies of buildings.

Phase II

MIS will provide additional access points within buildings (hallways, lounges, lobbies, etc) to help clear up problem areas.

MIS will bring on board Spring Lake Campus and Horticulture Educational Center.

Please remember the wireless network is a convenient supplement to the FTCC wired network infrastructure and is not a replacement for your existing network connectivity in your offices, computer labs, and classrooms.

Using Wireless

For most users, accessing the wireless network is as easy as launching a web browser and logging on. However, if you do need assistance we have included some general instructions for setting up, and instructions for logging on.

- · Users can be currently enrolled students, faculty, and staff.
- You must use your User ID (same as for Web Advisor) and Password (initially birth date, MMDDYY, then
 you are required to change it) to complete login.
- When logging in you are required to read all of the "Acceptable Use Guidelines" and "Agree" to them. You are responsible for the contents, and your access can be terminated if the guidelines are not followed.
- Logged in sessions are limited to 4 hours. After time has expired you will be logged off WITHOUT warning.

FTCC <u>Acceptable Use Guidelines</u> for the Wireless Network are located in the Administrative Procedures Manual, Section I-23.10.5.

All users of the FTCC Wireless Network must read and accept the guidelines before completing a login.
