

Description of State System Operation

Fayetteville Technical Community College (NCCCS) is part of the North Carolina Community College System. In accordance with the Commission Policy "Reaffirmation of Accreditation and Subsequent Reports" the following description of the NCCCS mission, governance, operating procedures for the system and FTCC's role in the system is provided.

NCCCS Working Mission Statement: The mission of the NCCCS is to open the door to high-quality, accessible educational opportunities that minimize barriers to post-secondary education, maximize student success, develop a

globally and multi-culturally competent workforce, and improve the lives and well-being of individuals by providing:

- Education, training and retraining for the workforce, including basic skills and literacy education, occupational and pre-baccalaureate programs.
- Support for economic development through services to and in partnership with business and industry and in collaboration with the University of North Carolina System and private colleges and universities.
- Services to communities and individuals which improve the quality of life.

GOVERNANCE: The State of North Carolina has assigned the 58 public community colleges to the State Board of Community Colleges. The Board has full authority to adopt all policies, regulations and standards it may deem necessary for operation of the System. The NCCCS Office serves as a resource agency and an administrative arm of the State Board. In 1999, the General Assembly officially changed the System Office name from the Department of Community Colleges to the North Carolina Community College System Office.

The State Board is responsible solely for the Community College System and is not under the domain of any other board or commission. Members of the State Board are selected by the Governor and the General Assembly. Members represent business, industry, education, and government.

The Board consists of 21 members. The Lieutenant Governor and the State Treasurer are ex officio members. The Governor appoints 10 members, four from the state at large and one from each of the six trustee regions. Four are elected by the Senate and four more by the House. The president or vice president of the North Carolina Comprehensive Community College Student Government Association serves as an ex officio member. Terms are staggered and expire every odd-numbered year. No person may be appointed or elected to more than two consecutive terms of six years.

The Board meets at least ten times per year to evaluate the recommendations of the System Office, to set policy for the System, and to oversee its operation. Members elect a board chair to serve as the Board's leader, spokesperson, and presiding officer. The Chair is responsible for projecting the public image of the Board and providing positive leadership.

The System Office, headed by the System President, provides state-level administration and leadership of the Community College System under the direction of the State Board of Community Colleges.

Governance Control (continued)

The State Board has three major functions: (1) equitable distribution of funds and fiscal accountability, (2) establishing and maintaining state priorities, and (3) educational program approval and accountability. Through the exercise of its authority in these areas, the State Board can recommit the System to existing policies or alter the direction of the System through changes in policy. The State Board has four goals:

- Economic and Workforce Development: To support North Carolina businesses, industries and citizens in growing the North Carolina economy and to enhance the level of workforce technology by preparing competent workers.
- Enrollment Management: To meet increasing diverse learners' needs through innovative non-traditional and traditional programs.
- Accountability in the use of technology: To assess the effective and efficient use of information technology.
- Development of Resources: To account for and equitably distribute appropriations and to continuously analyze and articulate resources necessary to fulfill the North Carolina Community College System mission.

As part of its administrative function, the System Office provides support services for the various program offerings such as nursing, agriculture, and business. The System President's staff assists staff at the colleges by helping to develop and implement curriculums and other programs and by providing technical assistance in a range of areas. The System Office provides other services for the System that would be difficult for an individual institution to initiate, such as statewide data collection.

At the local level, each of the colleges operates under a board of trustees. Each board is composed of a minimum of twelve citizens from the service area in which the college is located. The president or chairman of the executive board of the student body serves as an ex officio member. Local board members are appointed for staggered four-year terms. Four members each are elected by the local school board and the board of commissioners of the administrative area of the institution. Four members are appointed by the Governor.

The local board of trustees sets local policy. The local board elects and the State Board approves selection of each college's president. The president operates the college within state policies and policies adopted by the local trustees. Administrative decisions, such as employment of faculty members, may be made by the president. All personnel employed at the colleges are employees of the college and not of the State of North Carolina.

OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR THE SYSTEM OFFICE: The North Carolina Community College System Office assists the colleges in a wide range of functional areas including, but not limited to:

- **Audit Services:**

The mission of the Audit Services Unit is to ensure accountability and credibility of the North Carolina Community College System in a consultative and proactive manner. This mission is accomplished by conducting annual audits of each of the 58 colleges thereby ensuring compliance with the North Carolina General Statutes, *Title 23 of the North Carolina Administrative Code*, State Board of Community Colleges policies and guidelines and North Carolina Community College System Office Numbered Memoranda.

- **Business and Finance Support:**

The **Division of Business and Finance** supports the mission of the Community College System by procuring and allocating resources and by providing technical assistance to the 58 colleges. The organization is comprised of two major areas: (1) **Budgeting and Accounting** manages the financial operations of the system and offers technical assistance to the colleges and (2) **Administrative and Facility Services** coordinates the acquisition and disposition of property and equipment with the colleges and the system office and supplies auxiliary services to the other divisions of the system office. As good stewards of the state's financial resources, both sections strive to pursue legitimate and sound business practices at the colleges and at the system office.

- **Computer Information Systems Projects and Training:**

The vision statement of CIS Projects and Training is to provide a comprehensive, fully integrated information system for the future that will support student-centered learning, management decisions, accountability to internal and external constituencies, and administrative and educational support operations through a flexible, seamless electronic network that is accessible to all.

- **Data Warehouse (Data collection and analysis assistance):**

The North Carolina Community College System data warehouse gives colleges and the system office personnel access to state-level information. This information includes student enrollments, faculty and staff employment, and course offerings. Users work with the BusinessObjects software to analyze and report data from the data warehouse.

- **Legal Affairs:**

Legal Affairs provides guidance and advice related to the North Carolina Administrative Code, Chapter 23, pertaining to rules regarding community colleges and monitors for compliance at the 58 Community Colleges and within the System Office staff.

Governance Control (continued)

- **Library Resources (Learning Technology Systems):**

The mission statement of the Learning Technology System is to be committed to customer service and dedicated to acting as a catalyst for positive change. Learning Technology Systems provides leadership to the fifty-eight institutions and the System Office through policy development, coordination of planning and assessment, development of information and reporting systems, negotiation and brokerage of services, and technology assistance for library resources, teaching, and learning. Learning Technology Systems provides leadership in planning, development, implementation and support of technologies and resources that support library resources, teaching, and learning. The section is responsible for system wide services for instructional and distance learning technology.

- **Numbered Memorandums :**

Numbered memos are official communications between the NC Department of Community Colleges and its 58 institutions designed to assist with consistency of operations across the System.

- **Planning and Accountability:**

Provide assistance in the strategic planning, assessment, and accountability measures for the 58 Community Colleges and the Systems Office. This offices provides advice and guidance in external reporting including, but not limited to, IPEDS, NC Higher Education Reports, and federal and state reporting requirements.

- **Systems and Technical Support:**

This office provides technical assistance for information management systems to the colleges and the system office staff.

FTCC's Role in the System: FTCC is one of the 58 colleges within the North Carolina Community College System supporting the System Office's primary goal of creating hope, opportunity, and jobs for more than 800,000 students and for the communities in which they live and work. The System Office expects all 58 colleges to provide services to their local service area as shown below:

Governance Control (continued)

The North Carolina Community College System offers a comprehensive range of educational programs to meet the needs of local communities for workforce preparedness and higher academic education, basic educational skills, job retraining, personal growth and development, and community and economic development. These programs are organized under several broad categories.

Curriculum programs are made up of credit courses leading to certificates, diplomas, or associate degrees, which range in length from one semester to two years. Most of the programs offered within the Community College System are designed to prepare individuals for entry level technical positions in business and industry with an associate of applied science degree. Each college also offers credit courses in the arts and sciences leading to an associate degree designed to transfer at the junior level into a senior college or university. Developmental education courses are available for students who need to improve their skills so they can perform at the level required for college transfer, certificate, diploma and associate degree programs. Developmental education programs consist of courses and support services which include, but are not limited to, diagnostic assessment and placement, tutoring, advising, and writing assistance. These courses do not earn credit toward a degree, diploma or certificate but provide the student with courses for academic readiness.

Another category of programs is continuing education. These non-credit courses may be occupational, academic, or avocational in nature. Some are offered as a categorically-funded community service. Others are designed to upgrade occupational skills and are funded through enrollment driven formulas. Each of the colleges also offers instruction in basic academic skills which include Adult Basic Education (K-8 and basic literacy skills), Adult High School and GED programs (9-12 academic preparation), Compensatory Education, and English as a Second Language (ESL).

Because of the unique character of community colleges, student services program play an especially important role in the life of the colleges. Students receive academic, personal and career counseling services, special assessment and placement assistance, help in the transition to work and job development, and a variety of other services which are essential to the success of the instructional programs.

Finally, there is a broad effort in specialized programming, often targeting the economic development of the community. Customized Training and the Small Business Center Network provide direct consulting and customized training to business and industry to promote their success. The Human Resources Development and Job Training Partnership Act Programs provide services and training specifically targeted to the unemployed and disadvantaged. A variety of other programs connects the colleges uniquely to the needs and aspirations of their communities.

Institutional Information for Reviewers

- 1. History and Characteristics:** In 1961, the Fayetteville Area Industrial Education Center (IEC) opened in Cumberland County supporting the seven-county service area of Cumberland, Hoke, Bladen, Robeson, Sampson, Scotland, and Harnett counties. In January 1964, the IEC was renamed Fayetteville Technical Institute (FTI) and the institution was granted authority to award the Associate in Applied Science Degree in addition to diplomas/certificates. FTI was accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools in 1967. In January 1988, FTI became Fayetteville Technical Community College (FTCC). The College has continued to expand from its original 10 acres to 209.26 acres with locations now at our Main Campus, Spring Lake, the Horticulture Education Center, and the future FTCC Western Campus. The mission of FTCC is "Serve our community as a learning-centered institution to build a globally competitive workforce supporting economic development." The student population consists of White (45%), Non-White (55%), Male (43%), Female (57%) and the majority of students are within ages 18 to 44 (74%). FTCC is geographically located close to Fort Bragg, NC and supports soldiers that are deployed with a large contingent of "GoArmyEd" students. FTCC is a premier leader in the new Interactive 3-D (i3D) Technology and also houses the North Carolina Military Business Center. FTCC adheres to an "Open Door" admissions policy. FTCC has 3 peer institutions within the 58 community colleges of the NC Community College System (NCCCS): (1) Central Piedmont Community College, (2) Guilford Technical Community College, and (3) Wake Technical Community College.
- 2. List of Degrees and the Majors or Concentrations:** FTCC, as the fourth largest community college in NCCCS, has 161 degree, diploma and certificate offerings (See **Attachment A** for the listing of Curriculum Programs).
- 3. Locations and Distance Education:** FTCC provides course work towards a degree, diploma or certificate that can be obtained primarily through traditional classroom instruction at 25 different sites (See **Attachment B**). Additionally, the sites listed within Attachment B indicate whether the degree is offered partially or completely and shows which of those sites allow a student to obtain 50 percent of required credits toward any of the educational programs. FTCC also offers 99 of the 161 degrees, diplomas and certificates via distance education, primarily through the use of Internet classes. Students enrolled within these programs can, if desired, obtain most of their credit requirements primarily through electronic means (See **Attachment C**).

- 5. Relationship to the US Department of Education:** FTCC has not been limited, suspended, or terminated by the U.S. Department of Education in regards to student financial aid programs during the previous 3 years. The College was required to reimburse \$575.88 due to a 2007 Single Audit conducted by the Office of the State Auditor. In the subsequent year, State Auditors followed up with the College on the satisfactory academic progress issue that caused the error. As a result, auditors closed the finding, which is indicated in the 2008 Statewide Single Audit Report.

The College was required to reimburse \$433,591 due to a program review of the 2007-08 and 2008-09 award years, performed by the U.S. Department of Education's School Participation Team. Ninety-six percent of the liability was the result of one issue. Three percent of the liability was interest. The College awarded Title IV funds for enrollment purposes after students exceeded the 30 semester hour limit for remedial work. Since the review, financial aid administrators have worked diligently with the College's MIS group to create an automated report that is reviewed prior to posting any financial aid awards to students' accounts. This is currently an established business process for monitoring developmental credit hours within the financial aid office. The report indicates students' cumulative enrollment in developmental credit hours and is an excellent monitoring device to prevent a similar finding in the future.
